

COVID Policy: Liability Waiver and Assumption of Risk

Attendee understands that participation in Healing Beyond Border's (HBB's) 2021 Annual Conference is entirely voluntary and requires attendees to abide by any applicable rules of conduct or local or state laws that may be announced at any time during the Annual Conference. Specifically relating to the global COVID-19 pandemic, attendee acknowledges the highly contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assumes the risk of exposure or infection by attending the Annual Meeting and understands that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, disability, and/or death to attendee. Attendee understands that the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19 at the Annual Conference may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of others who may attend the meeting or their families, colleagues, or others with whom they may have contact. Accordingly, attendee understands and agrees that this release includes any claims based on the actions, omissions, or negligence of HBB and its Executive Board and officers, Governing Board of Directors, employees, or agents from any and all liability in connection with HBB's Annual Conference.

In addition to all other rules and regulations relating to the attendee's attendance, attendee agrees to comply with all COVID-related procedures that may be implemented by HBB, the city of Broomfield/Denver and the OMNI Interlocken Hotel, including, but not limited to, mask-wearing and social distancing requirements and restrictions on certain activities that carry higher COVID-related risk, in order to protect as much as possible, the health and safety of all meeting attendees.
